## Ben Bridgewater

Ben Bridgewater is a consultant cardiac surgeon at the University Hospital of South Manchester and Honorary Professor at Manchester Academic Health Science Centre . He was the clinical director for cardiac surgery 2005-2008 and 2010 to date and Chairman of the Trust Clinical Audit committee 2000-2008 . He has published papers on the methodology of risk adjustment in cardiac surgery, he was responsible for publishing named surgeon mortality for CABG and AVR operations from a group of surgeons in Northwest England, and he worked with the Guardian newspaper on their publication of national named surgeon mortality data in 2005 . He is a clinical lead at the National Institute for Clinical Outcomes Research at UCL where he is leading on publishing of surgical outcomes data . More recently he has published major national and international cardiac surgery benchmarking reports, and explored issues of cultural change with the medical profession as a response to benchmarking clinical data .
